The Brunswick FFA Alumni Scholarship 2024

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide assistance to those graduating FFA members who plan to pursue a post secondary education, (University, Four Year College, Two Year College or Vocational/Technical School).

II. SCHOLARSHIP

All scholarship applicants will be considered on an individual basis and will be awarded some financial aid as determined by the Scholarship Committee. The presentation of the scholarship/s will take place at the annual Brunswick FFA Parent/Member Banquet. The award money will be made payable to the institution's Financial Aid Office after completion of the recipient's first semester. A copy of his/her transcript or grade report must be presented to the FFA Alumni Treasurer in order for the scholarship funds to be forwarded to the institution's Financial Aid Office. Recipients will have two years to claim his/her scholarship as stated in the scholarship letter. Any circumstances requiring an extension will be reviewed by the Alumni Scholarship Committee.

III. Each applicant must:

1. Be a graduating senior of Brunswick High School who has applied or been accepted for entrance to post secondary/vocation/technical facility.
2. Be a student planning to attend an institution of higher learning to further his/her education for a future purpose or intent.
3. Have a satisfactory scholastic record, with at least a 3.0 in Ag-related classes and 2.5 in all scholastic classes.
4. Be member of an FFA Chapter for at least (2) two years and have been actively involved and shown personal dedication to the FFA through projects and activities.

IV. APPLICANT'S RESPONSIBILITY:

Each applicant must present the following items to the Guidance Office at Brunswick High School no later than the end of school day by the third Friday of APRIL (April 19, 2024 NOTE: If School is closed on this day, it will then be due by the end of the schoo4 day on the following Monday.

IV. APPLICANT'S RESPONSIBILITY; (CONTINUED)

1. A COMPLETED scholarship application form.
2. An official copy of his/her Brunswick High School transcript.
3. Two letters of recommendation from unrelated persons. (ex: teacher, minister, employer, etc.) (Xerox copies accepted).

V. FFA ALUMNI RESPONSIBILITY:

1. To set aside funds from Community Show activities for scholarship purpose each year.
2. To appoint a committee of two or more persons that will review and evaluate scholarship applications.
3. To award the available scholarship money to the most deserving applicant/s.

VI. SELECTION PROCESS

1. FFA Alumni Scholarship Committee will convene in private for recipient selection. Scholarships will be awarded at the Annual FFA Chapter Banquet.
2. All factors concerning applicant's eligibility will be considered in the assessment process.
