SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

You may apply for this scholarship if you are:

- A. a graduating senior or a graduate of a public school, home school or private school in Frederick County Maryland

or

- B. an out of Frederick County student who is the son, daughter, grandson or granddaughter of a member in good standing of the Catoctin Fish and Game Association

or

- C. you are currently enrolled in college majoring in environmental science, natural resources management or a related field and can meet either of the above conditions

HOW TO APPLY

Submit the completed application by April 15th of the current year along with an official grade transcript to:

TO RECEIVE PAYMENT

The recipient must carry a minimum of 12 college credit hours and maintain a 3.0 GPA or better. An official transcript of grades is to be submitted to the scholarship committee upon completion of the semester following the awarding of the scholarship. Payment will be made directly to the educational institution.

APPLICATION EVALUATION

The scholarship will be evaluated on transcript information, outdoor work and activities, outdoor organization involvement and outdoor community service involvement.
