BHS SAFE AND SANE Class of 2024

Safe and Sane is a nonprofit organization established to address the very serious issues of youth drinking, drug use and driving behavior during the highest risk social events of their lives

- Raise funds to give the Class of 2024 a safe and supervised party after they graduate. Buses transport to and from the event
- All graduates are invited and encouraged to attend the overnight celebration, and are not allowed to leave the event once it begins
- Parents volunteer to chaperone at the event. supervise the kids all night and once the kids arrive at the Safe and Sane Party, they are not allowed to leave until the next morning

The Corporation is organized exclusively for the charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 509(a)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC) and is also tax-exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the IRC





Where: Adventure Park USA, New Market, MD

When: May 21, 2024 10:30 pm – 4:30 am. Graduates transported by buses at BHS at 10:30 pm, and will return to BHS around 5:00 am on May 22

What: A lock-in celebration that provides the Graduates access to all indoor activities and most outdoor activities, as well as food and beverage

There is no cost for your child to attend the Adventure Park party! We want this to be an inclusive event for ALL students and make it as equitable as possible.

Not have been involved in inappropriate or unlawful behavior leading to suspension before or during practice period.
Fulfill all financial obligations.

Fulfilling Financial Obligations

- A students with an extraordinary reason must present written request to Mr. Berry prior to May 10.
- A student who misses rehearsal without prior written permission will not be permitted to participate in the Graduation Ceremony.

Graduation Rehearsal Guidelines

- All school rules and policies apply at rehearsals.
- Students may not bring guests or family members.
- Students should not bring cell phones, backpacks or personal items to the rehearsal.
- ✤ Valuables should be left at home.
- ✤ No food or beverage is permitted.
- All seniors are expected to leave school grounds after the rehearsal.
- No senior should attend under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Any discipline may exclude a senior from participation in the graduation ceremony.

Graduation Ceremony

Knott Arena at the PNC Sports Complex on the Campus of Mount St. Mary's University

- Graduates need to arrive by 8:00 am
- ✤ Gates open for guests at 8:00 am
- Please leave plenty of time for travel, parking and walking to the venue
- ✤ Please say goodbye to your graduate once inside
- No guest is admitted without a ticket
- Accessibility seating will be available, more details on a later slide.



Dress Code for Graduation

All graduates MUST wear a cap, gown and tassel

- NO decorating graduation cap, cap should be worn level with the floor.
- Stoles, honor cords and medals must be bestowed by FCPS or the State of Maryland. Those bestowed by outside (non-FCPS) organizations or purchased by families may not be worn during the ceremony.
- Appropriate attire should be worn by graduates under the gown:
 - Boys slacks, collared shirt, tie, dark shoes avoid gym shorts, jeans, t shirts, sneakers.
 - <u>Girls</u> dress, dress slacks, skirt, blouse and low shoes - avoid high heels, flip flops



Graduation Tickets

- Graduates receive 10 tickets per graduates who are participating in the ceremony.
- Tickets will be distributed on the last day of graduation practice - Monday, May 20th.
- Tickets will not be given until all obligations to BHS are cleared.
- Every person entering the arena needs a ticket. Children 1 and older require a ticket.
- Graduates do not require a ticket.
- Extra tickets must be requested using the form from the senior packet.



Priority Seating Request

- All families who require accessibility seating should complete the Seating Accommodation Request in the Senior Packet.
- The deadline for priority seating requests is Friday, May 10th.
- All individuals attending the graduation ceremony, regardless of seat assignment, must have a graduation ticket.
- * Please arrive early in order to best facilitate priority seating.



Livestreaming and Photography

- Due to the limited number of guests, each graduation will be professionally live streamed, so that friends, family and community members can view the ceremony in real time.
- A recording of the ceremony will also be available on the individual school and FCPS YouTube channels.
- Links to each livestream will be provided prior to the event.
- A professional photographer from Victor O'Neill Studios will take graduate pictures as they cross the stage - they will be available for order online.
- If you wish to take pictures during the ceremony, you must remain in your seat.



Graduation Ceremony Etiquette

So that all in attendance may enjoy this exciting ceremony we ask that all guests:

- * The ceremony lasts for approximately 90 minutes. Please be comfortable and take care of all needs in advance.
- * Be seated and in place 10 minutes prior to the ceremony.
- Please limit your applause so that all graduate names can be heard by their guests.
- * DO NOT bring anything that will obstruct anyone's point of view including: airhorns, balloons, or signs. They will be TURNED AWAY at the door.
- Please treat the event more like a wedding or official occasion rather than a sporting event.

Important Graduation Reminders

- * Allow plenty of time for traffic and to be on time arrive by 8:00am.
- One more time you must have a ticket to enter the arena.
- * During the student opening processional, the doors will be closed and no guests will be admitted.
- Students receive a diploma cover when crossing the stage - they receive their actual diploma after the ceremony.
- * All pictures after the ceremony MUST be taken outside.
- * Make a plan for meeting your graduate after the ceremony, outside of the Knott Arena.
