Quick with a warm smile and kind word, Andy sparked the groups around him to higher cooperation and achievement. Andy's approach to life was a shining example of how one person could positively impact others.

Applications from graduating seniors of Brunswick High School must be submitted **on or before April 30** to the BHS Guidance Office. Applicants must have a weighted GPA of at least 3.5. Applications will be reviewed by a committee of Andy's family members and PTSA members non-related to any of the applicants. This award will be presented to a graduating senior at the annual Brunswick High School Awards Assembly.

Student Application Procedure:

- 1. Complete this student application form.
- 2. Obtain1-2 letters of endorsement from a faculty member, a minister or a non-related community person who will attest to your character and service to others. Letters should provide specific acts revealing how the applicant has demonstrated service to others and/or been an example various points of the Scout Law: trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean and reverent. Letters should be sealed and accompany the application.
- 3. Choose and complete **one** of the following essay questions (please limit your answer to approximately one page).
 - a. Describe how you have demonstrated service to others and/or encouraged others to do their best both in and out of school.
 - b. Describe how you demonstrate the Scout Law in everyday life: trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean and reverent. (You do not have to be a Scout to choose this option.)
 - c. Why are you a good candidate to receive this award?
