Teacher Recommendations	 Consider 2 teachers to ask for letters of recommendation. Ask these teachers IN PERSON before school lets out. There will be a step later (in Naviance) where you will request the recommendation electronically; you will assign teachers to specific schools. 			
Complete your Recommendation BRAG sheet Counselor Assignments →	To Access your BRAG Sheet, Log into Naviance and click: Initials (top right) → "Surveys From Your School" → "Recommendation Brag Sheet" This helps your recommenders write a better letter. Complete by July 1 (or sooner!) Save progress frequently with the <u>Submit</u> button. Responses are lost if Naviance times out. College Searches		 Continue searching for colleges - Naviance - SuperMatch College Search. Academic Common Market – for in-state tuition, specific to majors. 		
Keep a list of potential schools	 Target schools & come up with a list of potential schools. A good number is 5-8 schools. Have at least one "safe school"- a school you are sure to get into. Keep a list of schools in Naviance – "Colleges I'm Thinking About." Do not attempt to request transcripts or recommendations in Naviance at this time. Counselors will train you on that process after school starts. 			
Work on College Applications	 Research types of applications required – go to COLLEGE websites. Start working on applications as soon as they are available. This date varies! Typically, <u>August 1</u> is the open date – especially for the Common Application. Many colleges have application deadlines between <u>Oct 15 - Dec 1</u>. 			
Write your Application Essays	 You can access essay topics on the Applications. Common App essay topics are already posted on the website: <u>https://www.commonapp.org/blog/2023-2024-common-app-essay-prompts</u> 			
Senior Class Schedule	 Schedules released in Schoology & Parent/Guardian Email on August 16. Schedule changes - permitted ONLY with a VALID reason (error in schedule). Minimal elective changes. It's important to MAINTAIN the RIGOR of your senior schedule. 			
TESTING	 Evaluate where you stand with ACT and SAT scores. Some colleges/universities are still "test optional." It is your responsibility to determine if entrance exam scores are required for admission. You need to look at college/university websites for this. Consider application deadlines when choosing test dates. ACT Registration is at <u>www.act.org/register</u> SAT Registration is at <u>www.sat.org/register</u>
