New Sequence

Course must be taken sequentially. Starting school year 2022-2023, students who have taken CD 1 but not the other courses, must take *Preschool Learning Strategies* BEFORE *Preschool Methods and Materials*.

ECED 125 - Methods and Materials in Early Childhood (3)

Prerequisite or Co-requisite: [ECED 101](#)* or ED 100 (formerly ECD 104)

Designed to teach the methods and proper use of materials in presenting creative learning experiences to young children in the areas of language, creative dramatics, art, music, movement, math, science, emergent literacy, and outdoor activities. This course meets the state requirements for Office of Child Care Licensing & Credentialing. This course is 45 hours of the 90 hours required for Preschool Lead Teacher. Fifteen hours of documented observation are required.

*FCPS CD 1 Child Growth and Development aligns and articulates with pre-req ECED 101; FCC will accept CD 1 in place of that course.

How will FCPS offer Dual Enrollment?

This offering is planned for systemic synchronous instruction block 1, semester 2 with one teacher teaching all schools virtually. We hope to have enough enrollment systemically to offer two sections: M/W and T/Th.

What if a student has already taken FCPS Preschool Methods and Materials?

We will have two course numbers this year so that students who have previously taken our Methods and Materials will still be able to take this course (for school year 2022-2023 only). There are enough differences in the syllabi, course content and the text, that students will still benefit.
