In addition, the registration survey will require an electronic parent signature and a parent email. The survey **has to be completed in one sitting**, so please mark your choices on this paper before you begin.
2. When you have made your choices and you are ready to complete your registration, log onto Naviance: <https://student.naviance.com/brunswickhi>  
If you land on the Naviance school lookup page use zip code 21716 to find Brunswick High School.  
Click "Student," click "**Continue with Single Sign On**," and sign in with your regular FCPS account.
3. At the top right click on your initials → Click "Surveys from Your School"  
Click on "**2024-2025 BHS 12th Grade Registration**."
4. Answer survey questions carefully. Please review and select your courses on this paper first, and then plan to do the registration survey in one sitting. At the end of the survey be sure to click "**SUBMIT RESPONSES**."
