All-County Guest Conductor Mr. David Kauffman

David Kauffman is currently the Senior Manager of the Apex Arts Magnet program in Anne Arundel County. He directs the CYSO Jazz Combo in Annapolis and is a director of the Apex Arts Commercial Band. Prior to moving to Anne Arundel County, he served as Fine Arts Coordinator and Assistant Principal in Allegany County; established Maryland high school band programs at Mountain Ridge (Allegany County) and Patuxent (Calvert County) High Schools; and directed the bands at Fort Hill and Beall High Schools (Allegany County). In each of his teaching positions, his groups consistently achieved superior ratings locally, regionally, and statewide. Kauffman has served as an educator, clinician, adjudicator, guest conductor, performer, promoter, businessman, and elected official for nearly thirty years. He is on the Board of Directors for the Jazz Education Network and serves on the Executive Committee as the organization's Secretary. He was a member of the National Association for Music Education's (NAfME) Council for Jazz Education from 2013-2022 and served as its Chair from 2018-2022. He is a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. He lives in Baltimore, Maryland, with his wife, Jennifer and their dogs Stella and Cosmo. They have two adult children, Kaitlyn and Sam.
