CHORUS

Dr. Amy Voorhees is the Director of Choral Activities at Susquehanna University and holds the Cyril M. Stretansky Professorship in Choral Music. A graduate of Michigan State University and a University Distinguished Fellow, Dr. Voorhees also holds a B.M. degree in Vocal Performance from Simpson College, has additional Music Education training from Iowa State University, and a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from Drake University. Prior to her studies at MSU, Voorhees taught public school for over fifteen years with experience at the Elementary, Middle and High School levels. Additionally, she has served as an adjunct faculty member for Drake University teaching a vocal jazz methods course. Dr. Voorhees is in demand as a clinician, guest conductor, and presenter. She has worked with choirs and conducted festivals in Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, Colorado, Virginia, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Maryland and Pennsylvania. ORCHESTRA

Dr. Christopher Cicconi, is Director of Bands and Orchestras and Associate Professor of Music Education at Towson University. Prior to his arrival in Maryland, Cicconi earned a Doctoral of Musical Arts Degree in Instrumental Conducting from the University of Miami, where he was awarded a Henry Mancini Fellowship. Cicconi is in demand throughout the Mid-Atlantic region and is a sought-after guest conductor, clinician, and guest speaker. Upon his arrival in Maryland, he has appeared as a band and orchestra clinician in well over 100 public and private institutions. As a guest conductor, Cicconi has appeared with All-State, All-Region, and All-County Bands and Orchestras in numerous states around the country including Maryland, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Georgia. His most recent publication, 'The Band Music Handbook, A Catalog of Emerging Band Repertoire,' has proved to be a valuable resource and essential tool for wind band directors worldwide. Travis is also a member of Phi Beta Mu (Nu Chapter), ASCAP, and the National Band Association. He has previously served on the Phi Beta Mu International Board of Directors. He has presented on instrumental music education at the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic, PMEA and OMEA State Conferences, professional development sessions for music education, and secondary music methods classes in higher education. As a composer, Travis has published works available from Bandworks Publications, The FJH Music Company, Grand Mesa Music, C.L.
