Mr. Charles H. Doherty

Charles Doherty is the director of Instrumental Music at Damascus High School, leading two bands, one jazz band, and two string orchestras. He carries a Bachelor of Science degree in Music Education and a Master of Music in Trombone Performance from Duquesne University. Mr. Doherty also serves as the Artistic Director and conductor for the Academy of Saint Cecilia Youth Orchestra in Damascus, MD, and as conductor of the Symphonia, a group with the Frederick Regional Youth Orchestra. He has also conducted several senior and junior high honor bands. As a performer, Mr. Doherty has played with numerous groups in the DC area, including the Mike Kamuf Little Big Band, Blue Moon Big Band, Martinsburg Jazz Orchestra, Yesterday Swing Orchestra, the Montgomery Philharmonic, and the Trinity Chamber Orchestra.
