**Frederick County Public Schools (MD)** is a successful school system in a diverse and growing community. Frederick County bridges rural, suburban, and urban lifestyles near both the Washington, DC and Baltimore metropolitan communities. Enrollment as of September 30, 2021, was over 45,000 students. The racial/ethnic composition of our student body is 52% White; 20% Hispanic/ Latino; 14% Black/African American; 7% Asian; 7% two or more races; and less than 1% American Indian/Alaskan Native and Pacific Islander/Native Hawaiian. We serve students with varying needs, including over 5,100 students receiving special education services (11%), about 3,300 English Learners (7%), and almost 13,300 receiving free or reduced-price meal services (29%).

**Oakdale High School** - Oakdale High School opened in August 2010 as the result of a countywide redistricting process. Anticipated enrollment for the 2023-2024 school year is approximately 1,600 students. The school serves an area that is primarily a residential suburb located approximately 6 miles east of Frederick, Maryland.
