

## BYOD for Elementary Students at Parkway Elementary



1. You are responsible for keeping your device safe. No one else at school is responsible for a lost, stolen, or damaged device. It is your responsibility.
2. Use skins or case to make it easy to know which device is yours. PES will provide an individualized label for you to affix to your skin or case.
3. Earbuds or headphones are required for you to provide for your device.
4. You must use the school's Wi-Fi. You may NOT use 3G or 4G at school. We will teach you how to access our Wi-Fi.
5. Charge your device before you bring it to school. Devices will not be charged at school.
6. You will never be required to bring your device to school.
7. Your device must stay in your backpack or binder at all times unless your teacher gives you permission to use it for learning. Your device should be in your backpack or binder during lunch, during class changes, during dismissal.
8. Your device remains in your book bag or binder whenever there is a substitute teacher.
9. Your device will be unable to print at school.
10. Your device must be on silent mode at all times unless being used for learning with your teacher's permission.
11. You may not use your device to make phone calls, instant message, text, etc.
12. You may not take pictures or videos of anyone at school unless your teacher is supervising you.
13. Educational games are only to be played on your device if they are part of your teacher's assignment.
14. You must follow any other rules or procedures your teacher may set up for your classroom. If you do not follow the rules/procedures then you may lose the right to bring a device to school.
